First Grade Norms

- 1. Don't speak while others are speaking.

Third Grade Norms

- 1. Respect others' opinions and listen.
- 2. Maintain respectful demeanor.
- 3. Agree to disagree
- 4. Constructive criticism
- 5. Supportive comments
- 6. Be prompt, prepared, ready
- 7. Shared responsibilities.
- 8. Be friendly, polite, and professional.
- 9. Follow schedule and stay on task.



Fourth Grade Norms

- 1. Be on time.
- 2. Be prepared.
- 3. Be respectful.
- 4. Don't talk over each other.
- 5. Participate!
- 6. Stay on task.
- 7. Be open-minded.
- 8. Use constructive criticism.

Fifth Grade Norms

- 1. Start on time and be prepared.
- 2. Review norms.
- 3. Equal contribution
- 4. Respect others and their ideas
- 5. What happens in the meeting, stays in the meeting.
- 6. Results must be defined and clear.
- 7. Celebrate successes.
- 8. Make S.M.A.R.T. goals.
