Topic: Turning Around Chronically Low-Performing Schools Practice: Focus on Instruction

This document provides a template for teachers to outline their instructional strategies for other staff. Teachers are asked to describe how a concept was taught and determine the percentage of students who met or exceeded the mastery benchmark on the concept. If less than 75 percent of students meet or exceed the mastery benchmark, the whole group must be taught the concept again. Teachers must outline how their teaching will be different from the original teaching of the concept. If more than 75 percent, but less than 100 percent of students meet or exceed the mastery benchmark, students needing extra help can be put into a small group intervention for reteaching the concept. Teachers must describe how they will teach the concept to meet these students' specific needs and record the percentage of these students that met the mastery benchmark. Teachers also need to plan strategies for sustained mastery of the concept over time for the entire group.
