Passport for Positive Behavior Hidden Hills Elementary School, Arizona

Topic: Reducing Behavior Problems Practice: Schoolwide Approach

Teachers at Hidden Hills Elementary School model behavior expectations with their students at the beginning of the school year. The behavior expectations for locations on the school grounds outside of classrooms are taken from the Behavior Matrix (see related sample material, *Behavior Matrix*), while behavior expectations inside classrooms are designed and written by each teacher in collaboration with all students in the class.

Each student receives a passport at the beginning of the school year. After initial lessons about the behavior expectations, teachers go with their students on a walk around the campus to model and demonstrate the rules of positive behavior. Students are engaged in following the teacher's modeled behaviors. For example, teachers take students as a group to the restrooms to practice entering and exiting cautiously, talking in quiet voices, and keeping the environment clean and tidy. Each page of the passport represents a different location on school grounds. When students successfully demonstrate the expected behavior during dedicated practice time, the teacher stamps the corresponding page in the passport. Teachers can use the passport and accompanying activities as a guide for the development of clear expectations and strategies to help students learn them.

- Walk on the sidewalks and cross in the cross walks.


Be Responsible

- Keep hands and feet to yourself.


Be Responsible

- Keep hands and belonging to yourself.


Be Responsible

- Stay in your class line.


Be Responsible

- · Keep your hands and feet to yourself.


Be Responsible

Be Responsible


- · Respond appropriately (example: applause, cheering, etc.)

- Walk your skateboards and bikes while on campus.



- Sit on your pockets.


Be Responsible

- Use the equipment correctly.


Be Responsible

- Use everything in the bathroom for its intended purpose.


Be Responsible

- Use "quiet" voices in the bathroom.


