In order to prepare students for academic success, counselors at Crossland High School work with them one-on-one to create and update an *Individualized Learning Plan* every year. This plan lists the mandated courses and academic standards for each year and provides a template students and counselors can use in creating an appropriate four-year course trajectory. Before beginning course planning, counselors schedule individual meetings with students to discuss and record strengths and talents, colleges of interest, academic goals and appropriate steps toward meeting them, and career goals. Students also list activities they plan to participate in during the school year.

Schedule Foreign Language as possible (3 years)
Special Ed students not meeting foreign language requirements can go into Technical
