Topic: Dropout Prevention

Practice: Data Systems

Del Valle High School uses a database to monitor performance and behavior data of students, plan interventions, and track the impact of each intervention. In this sample, showing the record for one student, each row on the spreadsheet represents a single, dated entry documenting a specific problem or intervention. Students with multiple issues reported become a high priority for discussion in team meetings. By recording and tracking data in this way, Del Valle can identify students who are at increased risk for dropping out and can then provide the students timely and targeted interventions. In addition to the sample student record, this sample material includes the complete lists of concerns and interventions for use. In the database, these options are accessible through dropdown menus. Middle and/or high school teachers and administrators can use a spreadsheet similar to this one to track interventions and concerns regarding student performance and behavior. This type of tracking can facilitate discussions on student progress, form a record of interventions, and increase alignment across interventions and different subject area teachers.
